A) 13U AA

- Provincial is in Abbotsford from August 9 to 12 (Thursday to Sunday)
- Winner qualifies for Westerns August 17-19 (Friday to Sunday) in La Broquerie, Manitoba
- Fee is \$200 per player and per coach.
- Baseball BC will cover airfare costs for the team that qualifies to the Westerns
- Team is responsible for their own hotels, meals and local transportation
- The Chef de Mission's flight is included in these numbers. Baseball BC will select and provide funding for the Chef de Mission.
- **B)** 13U AAA Two teams advance out of this tournament
- Provincial is in Abbotsford from August 8 to 11 (Wednesday to Saturday)

Provincial Winner:

- **Provincial winner** qualifies for Nationals August 23 to 26 (Thursday to Sunday) in Woodstock, ON
- Fee is \$400 for each player and per coach
- Baseball BC will cover will cover transportation costs to all out of province National Championships. Baseball BC will pay the \$4,000 Baseball Canada accommodation fee for the event in addition to hotel costs for the Tuesday night if required. Teams/players are responsible for their own meals. Baseball BC will book flights for 22 individuals for all out of province tournaments. Should a team not require this number of flights for players and coaches they will be required to pay the full cost of unused flights, which can be resold to the parents. The Chef de Mission's flight is included in these numbers. Baseball BC will select and provide funding for the Chef de Mission.

Runner-up:

- o Runner-up qualifies for Westerns August 16 to 19 (Thursday to Sunday) in Brandon, MB
- Fee is \$200 per player and per coach
- Baseball BC will cover airfare costs for the team that qualifies to the Westerns
- Team is responsible for their own hotels, meals and local transportation
- The Chef de Mission's flight is included in these numbers. Baseball BC will select and provide funding for the Chef de Mission.

All fees for Westerns and Nationals are payable to Baseball BC within five days of qualification.

Team Commitment Policy Performance Bond

Teams entering Baseball BC Provincial Championships are expected to make a commitment to play all scheduled games in the Provincial Championship and to attend any post-Provincial tournament (Western or National) that they qualify for.

A performance bond of \$2,000 by the entry date as a guarantee on this commitment. The performance bond will be returned at the successful conclusion of a team's participation in Baseball BC provincial programming.

Due to an agreement between Little League BC and Baseball BC, Little League teams are not required to pay an upfront performance bond. Little League BC requires teams to complete a contract with them in order for the bond to be guaranteed.

In District 6, the District will pay the entry fee of \$400 each for the 13U AA and AAA teams. Baseball BC's policy states that the entry fee for a Provincial Championship is non-refundable. Any team that withdraws after entering may forfeit their entry fee. Should a team withdraw after entering the tournament; the District will ask the leagues to repay the entry fee.

Forfeiture of the Performance Bond take place when:

- a team withdraws from a Provincial Championship (or Qualification Tournament) less than two weeks before the start of the event, or
- a team qualify for a Western or National Championship and choose not to attend.

Repayment of the performance bond will be based on per player's home league and the league will repay Little League British Columbia before August 31, 2018.

NOTE: Baseball BC will also impose sanction such as their future eligibility to participate in all Baseball BC programming and possible increased performance bonds in future seasons.
